

The Emerging National Leaders Programme equips current educational leaders with the insights, skills, and confidence to accelerate their career as they simultaneously strengthen the performance of their colleagues and their context. Learnings are related to the day-to-day realities and challenges of each participant's context. This process is enhanced through participant-generated discussions and ongoing mentoring and support by experienced Kaiarahi.

Due to this process, each delegate needs the support of its Senior (Principal or Board of Trustees Chairperson) to lead change management in an area of the school and to lead initiatives that align with the school's vision and values.

### Course Requirements:

The Emerging National Leaders Programme course requirements are:

- 1 x regional PLGs Workshops (Auckland/Wellington/Christchurch)
- 3 x e-Modules (Interpersonal and Educational) delivered as 3 korero per term
- 4 x mentoring sessions with one of the Emerging NLP Kaiarahi
- 1 x Professional Readings
- Approximate time requirement: 5-10 hours per term.

### Course Fee:

\$1497.00 +GST per person

(NB: Travel to PLG day and professional reading books (x1) are not covered in the course fee).

A deposit of \$599 is due within 7 days of registration to secure your place. The remaining course fee is due no later than 20 February 2021.

*Refund policy: Once your deposit has been received your position on NELP has been secured. We are unable to refund either the deposit or remove the obligation to make the final payment. This is due to the costs incurred with venue bookings, Kaiarahi employment and the fact that NELP will sell out meaning we have turned other delegates away. We are able to transfer your registration to another delegate who qualifies within your kura before the 31 January 2021.*

## Accreditation:

The Emerging National Leaders Programme is committed to seeing all delegates develop in interpersonal and behavioural dynamics associated with a leadership position within the education sector. Significant programme elements are: emotional intelligent leadership, culturally responsive leadership, communication styles/skills, conflict resolution, leading effective team meetings, winning with people and effectively leading from the middle.

On completion, delegates who graduate from the Emerging NLP receive Growth Culture accreditation (GC501) and the Emerging National Leaders Programme certification.
